# INTERNATIONAL 8TH SEPTEMBER 2023 LITERACY DAY

DO YOU THINK IT IS BETTER FOR STUDENTS TO WORK BEFORE THEIR UNIVERSITY STUDIES? WHY?

IS IT BETTER TO WORK BEFORE UNIVERSITY FOR SOCIAL SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE OR TO SPEND MORE TIME AND FOCUS ONLY ON HIGH-SCHOOL STUDIES? WHICH IS MORE PRODUCTIVE? WHAT IF STUDENTS NEED THE MONEY FROM A PART-TIME JOB WHEN THEY GO TO UNIVERSITY? IS WORKING BEFORE UNIVERSITY WORTHWHILE? IN THIS ESSAY, THESE INQUIRIES WITH THEIR DEBATABLE OPINIONS ARE GOING TO BE DISCUSSED THROUGHOUT.

ACCORDING TO RESEARCH, STUDENTS WHO WORKED MORE THAN 20 HOURS A WEEK HAD MUCH LOWER AVERAGE GRADE POINT AVERAGES - 2.95. UNFORTUNATELY, THIS PHENOMENON DISPROPORTIONATELY AFFECTS STUDENTS WHO FEEL THE MOST PRESSURE TO WORK. LOW-INCOME STUDENTS SHOULDER THE MOST RESPONSIBILITY WHEN FINANCING A COLLEGE EDUCATION; MANY THINK THAT WORKING MORE HOURS WILL HELP THEM MINIMIZE THEIR DEBT. FOR THESE STUDENTS, WORKING LESS THAN 20 HOURS A WEEK IS THE BALANCE BETWEEN COLLECTING MONEY AND EXPERIENCE WHILE GETTING A HIGH GPA. IN FACT, RESEARCH FOR THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS FOUND THAT STUDENTS WHO WORKED LESS THAN 20 HOURS PER WEEK HAD AN AVERAGE GPA OF 3.12, WHILE NONWORKING STUDENTS HAD AN AVERAGE GPA OF 3.04. ACCORDING TO THESE FINDINGS, IS IT A MORE USEFUL OPTION IF ALL STUDENTS WORK LESS THAN 20 HOURS A WEEK TO BENEFIT BOTH ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM?

GAINING WORK EXPERIENCE IS ALWAYS HELPFUL FOR ANYONE TO EXCEL AND BOOST THEIR CAREER AND SCORE GOOD GRADES IN STUDIES AS WELL. UNIVERSITIES IN NORTH AMERICA AND EUROPE OFTEN SEEK STUDENTS WHO HAVE PART-TIME JOB EXPERIENCE, ESPECIALLY THE IVY COLLEGES. THIS IS AS STUDENTS WHO CAN MANAGE THEIR TIME EFFICIENTLY AND CONTROL STRESS ARE MORE FAVORABLE TO THESE UNIVERSITIES. SO, DOES WORKING PRIOR TO UNIVERSITY GRANT AN ADVANTAGE IN COLLEGE ADMISSION?

ALL IN ALL, WORKING BEFORE UNIVERSITY HAS ITS FOR AND AGAINST. Some people believe that it is more beneficial for students to work before the university studies, and I totally support this idea. In this essay I am going to list some examples for a positive effect of having a gap year.

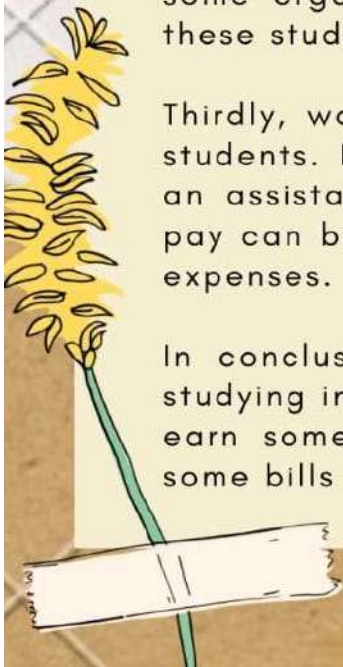
Firstly, the most important of these is the practical experience of the workplace that they will gain. As well as learning new job skills, their social skills will also improve as they interact with other employees.

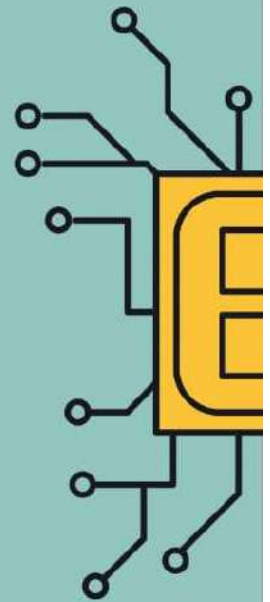

If you do have concerns, talk to your child's teacher for more strategies to help at home.

#### Reading

- Understands left-to-right and top-to-bottom orientation for books and print.
- Recognizes and can name all uppercase and lowercase letters.
- Enjoys being read to and can retell simple stories or what they learned in informational texts.
- Recognizes letters and letter sounds.
- Identifies and uses rhyming words.
- Can recognize beginning sounds and sometimes middle and end sounds in simple words.
- Identifies the sounds of each letter in simple, one-syllable words.
- Recognizes some "sight words," common words.
- Sound like they are reading when pretending to read.
- Connects information and events in texts to life and life to text experiences.
- Correctly answers questions about stories read aloud.
- Makes predictions based on illustrations or portions of stories.

#### Writing

- Independently writes many uppercase and lowercase letters (although they may not be clearly written).
- Writes own name (first and last) and the first names of some friends or classmates.
- Begins to write some words they use and hear often.
- Uses invented spelling — children at this age are translating the sounds of spoken words into writing.
- Begins to build a bank of correctly spelled words.
- Draws a picture that tells a story and adds labels to the picture.
- Writes (unconventionally) to express own meaning.
- Begins to write stories with some readable parts.





## PARENT TIPS TO SUPPORT MATH AT HOME

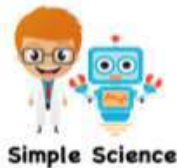
Help your child recognize shapes and size relationships

- At the grocery store, ask your child to find items that are triangles, circles, rectangles, and other shapes
- Ask your child to recognize or stack the groceries you bought by container shape or organize by size
- Organize a scavenger hunt where your child must find objects of different shapes
- Make snowflakes using symmetry. Fold a piece of paper in half diagonally to make a triangle, then fold in half 2 more times. Cut out small diamond or circular shapes from the edges, and then unfold it. Experiment with different numbers of folds and shapes.

## READING 101: A GUIDE FOR PARENTS

### What does it take to become a strong reader?

- **Print awareness** is the understanding that print carries meaning and that in English it reads from left to right. It also means learning that books contain letters and words, have front and back covers, and are handled in a certain way.
- **Phonological and phonemic awareness** is the ability to hear, identify, and play with the sounds in spoken language — including rhymes, syllables, and the smallest units of sound (phonemes).
- **Phonics** is a step-by-step way to teach the alphabetic principle — the idea that letters represent the sounds of spoken language — and that there is a predictable relationship between letters and sounds. "Decoding" is the act of sounding out words using phonics.
- **Fluency** is a child's ability to read a book or other text with accuracy, at a reasonable rate, and with appropriate expression. Reading fluency is important because it provides a bridge between word recognition and comprehension.
- **Vocabulary** is word knowledge. Word learning is an ongoing process — we are always adding to our "word bank." The goal is to recognize and understand the meaning of spoken and written words.
- **Comprehension** is the goal of reading! It is the thinking process readers use to understand what they read. Strong vocabulary, background knowledge, and an understanding of how language works are keys to comprehension.

## PARENT STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVING MATH

Try these useful strategies to help increase your child's Geometry Skills

- Fold a sheet of paper in half and have your child draw a shape along the fold; cut out the shape and unfold the paper to create a symmetrical shape
- Look around the house for different geometric shapes, such as triangles, squares, circles, and rectangles
- Use common household items, such as toothpicks, marshmallows, empty toilet paper rolls, twist ties, sticks, and paper, to construct shapes
- Help your child recognize and identify real-world examples of right-angles (e.g., the corner of a book) and parallel lines (e.g., railroad tracks)
- While driving together, direct your child to look for objects with the same size and shape
