- To encourage respect for the school environment.
- To celebrate achievement and raise self-esteem for all.
- To positively impact learning, through anchor charts and focus boards.

Display Guidelines

- It is imperative that our organization and presentation are of the highest standard and there is consistency throughout all subjects. Classroom displays show students that we value their work, while focus boards are a tool for learning.
- Anything displayed in the classroom should be simple, clear, conducive to learning, and referred to throughout the lesson.
- Subjects will be allotted a bulletin board. You may use blue tack/ staples to secure items
- If you want to display student work on a clothesline/string you should take permission from the administration and ensure that the camera view is not blocked
- The window on the classroom door should not be covered or blocked.
- Displays should be updated regularly for each unit of study.

What should be Displayed in the Classroom?

General Display

- Thematic work showing integrated subjects.
- Regularly used Visible Thinking Routines
- A unit overview with the standards being taught
- Learning objective and differentiated success criteria per period (on the whiteboard)
- Student work clearly labeled with the standard and learning objective
- Classroom information such as daily timetable, student jobs, behavior, and rewards where applicable.
- Anchor charts for student reference.
- The date and schedule (daily)
- The school rules (Be Safe, Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Ready)
- Safety notices - fire drill, school map
- School vision, mission, and values
- The seating plans.

English Display

- Current skills being taught - anchor charts to be referred to during each lesson
- Word Wall/Sound Wall
- APE (Answer, Prove, Explain), CUPS (Capitalization, Understanding, Punctuation, Spelling), Q-Chart
- Discussion prompts
- Useful vocabulary with picture cues to support ELL
- Samples of student work clearly labeled with the standard and objective

Math Display

- Current skills being taught - anchor charts to be referred to during each lesson

- Useful vocabulary with picture cues to support ELL
- Mathematical Practice Standards
- CUBES (Circle, Underline, Box key words, Evaluate the problem, Solve).
- Number Talks hand signals
- The problem of the week
- Samples of student work clearly labeled with the standard and objective

Science Display

- Useful vocabulary with picture cues to support ELL
- Interactive focus board
- CER (Claim, Evidence, Reasoning)
- Discussion prompts based on phenomena
- Current skills being taught - anchor charts to be referred to during each lesson
